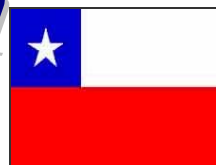


# Reaching children Raising up leaders

We want to update you concerning what has been happening in our lives these past several weeks, since Dad's promotion to glory.

As you know, Jim's father, John Mazurek died of a sudden, totally unexpected cardiac/pulmonary arrest last August 13, 2005 in Colorado Springs.

We are so thankful to the Lord for the fact that we were there, along with Jim's brother Robert and his wife Gail, to lend support to our mother, Lucille. We also thank Him for bringing along so many others who have supported us in many different ways. We are especially grateful to the hundreds who sent cards, letters, emails, and gifts to help Mom at this difficult time.

It is hard to find words to express our gratitude to Assemblies of God World Missions and Latin America Regional

Director, Dick Nicholson, for sending former Executive Director, Loren Triplett, and former Chilean General Superintendent, Rene Arancibia, to Colorado Springs, to have a part in the funeral services. Pastor Rob Cowles and all at Radiant Church in Colorado Springs have been simply wonderful beyond words. Their outpouring of love and support has taken forms too many to mention here.

Dad was buried at Fort Logan National Cemetery in Denver, with full military honors, in recognition of his sacrificial service during WWII.

We have been very busy since then, taking care of Dad's affairs here in Colorado, sorting things, holding garage sales, and preparing their house to go on the market. We have helped Mom move back home to McCook, NE, the land of her birth, where she still has a brother, a sister and several cousins in the community. Her new address is 1500 E. 11<sup>th</sup> St. Apt. 116, McCook, NE 69001. Mom is doing very well. Thank you for your prayers on her behalf.

We will be arriving back in Chile on October 17, to begin another term of missionary service. This will be an exciting time as we build the Santiago Children's Ministries Outreach Center. Thank you for all you have done for us this past year of deputation. We treasure your partnership. May the Lord fill your lives with His grace as He has ours throughout these past weeks.
